When will the new rate begin?

Rate changes will go into effect on October 1, 2025. This change in rate adheres to your contract by following a 60-day notice period.

What does the fee rate cover?

We charge a competitive fee of 1.1% to 1.25% which covers two components:

- An investment fee to pay our Financial Advisors & Investment Firm
- An administrative fee to pay for our staff and overhead costs

What returns can we expect?

In fiscal year 2025 (Jul '24-Jun '25) our long-term portfolio earned 13.42% annualized before fees; meaning our customers took home 12.42% net.

Over the past 5 years (as of 6/30/25), the long-term portfolio has earned 10.53% annualized before fees, and the short-term portfolio 5.02% annualized before fees.

What is your investment philosophy?

We use a Catholic values investment approach while concurrently maintaining a diverse portfolio.

- We follow USCCB Guidelines for Catholic Responsible Investing (CRI). Our 2025 fund audit demonstrated 0% direct conflict of interest among our\$42M+ in funds held.
- Diversification is an important strategy to ensure our portfolios are able to effectively manage risk, and
 also provide consistency to the returns generated over time. Our long-term pool of funds includes U.S.
 Equity, International Equity, Global Equity, U.S. Fixed Income, Alternative Investments and Money
 Market. Our short-term pool of funds includes U.S. Equity, International Equity, U.S. Fixed Income, and
 Money Market. The two funds primarily differ based on weighting between the asset class.
